Birding Expedition #1

This a good habitat for beginning birders. Ducks sit still for long periods of time and provide good practice in using binoculars.

Observations:

- Which ducks are skimming food off the surface of the water?
- Which ducks are diving?
- How long can the diving ducks stay underwater?
- Are there birds in the tule and cattails?
- What are the birds eating?
- Can you hear birds that you can't find?
- Look for bird footprints in the mud. What differences do you see in the tracks?
