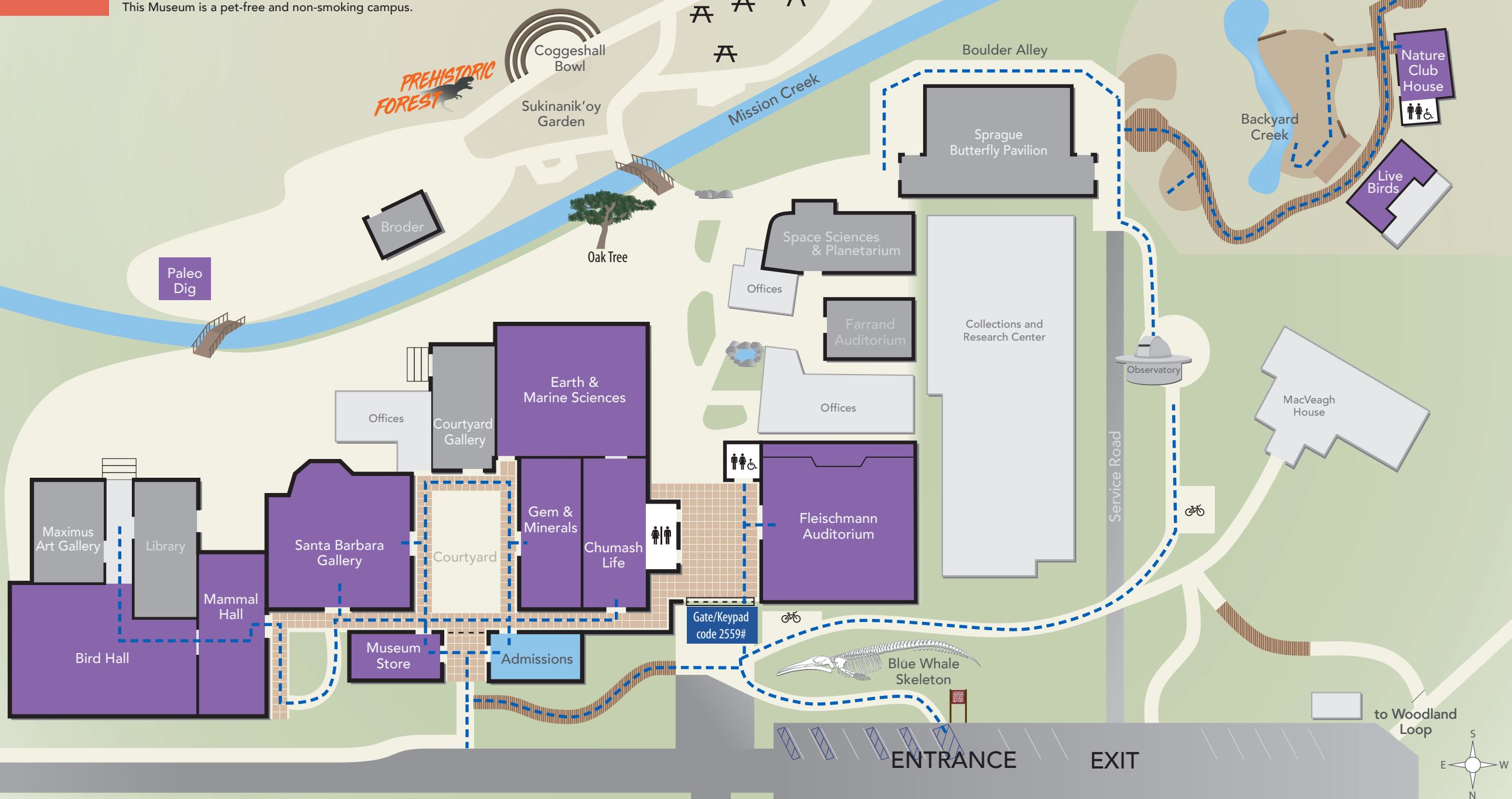


SANTA BARBARA
